**Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number and details of the proposals received by the Ministry under 'Make- in-India' Scheme;
- (b) the number of proposals approved by the Government till date and the Number of proposals pending along with reasons thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has received any proposal to develop the unused land of FACT, Kerala under the 'Make in India'; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the response of the Government in this regard?

**Answer**

(a) and (b): Under Modified – Special Incentive Package Scheme (M-SIPS), 58 proposals have been received involving investment of about Rs. 19057 Crores in electronics hardware manufacturing. Of these, 30 proposals have been approved and 5 more have been recommended for approval. The details of these proposals are at Annexure – I. Further, under Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC) Scheme, 34 proposals have been received with project outlay of Rs. 6295.93 Crores. Of these, 16 proposals have been accorded In- principle approval and 10 are under appraisal process as per the details at Annexure -II. Further, final approval has been granted to 2 Greenfield Electronic Manufacturing Clusters and 6 applications have been withdrawn by the concerned applicants for non-compliance of EMC scheme / guidelines.
