- (e) the time by which such laboratories are likely to become functional?

(a) to (e): No, Madam. There is no proposal under consideration of the Government to set up common testing laboratories in the country. Department of Commerce has proposed to the Government of Gujrat and the Government of Haryana that they can take initiatives to set up Common Lab. facilities for Medical Devices & Diagnostic equipments in their States for which funding under Assistance to States for Infras- tructure Development of Exports (ASIDE) scheme of Department of Commerce may be provided subject to satisfying the terms of the scheme.
