(a) to (c) No proposal has been received from the State Government of Gujarat and Union Territory of Daman and Diu to control pollution in Daman Ganga River. As per periodic assessment of the quality of water/ pollution level in the rivers conducted by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), the stretch from Vapi downstream to confluence with sea has been identified as polluted in Daman Ganga River.
