(c) whether the Government is making any effort to increase the capacity of Indian Navy in view of China deploying aircraft carrier and setting up naval base at Seychelles island; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): As per the information available, no Naval base has been established by China in Seychelles. However, Government is aware of Chinese participation in development projects in the Indian Ocean Region and keeps a constant watch on all developments concerning our national security.
