(a) to (d) The National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) has digitalised all its text books and has made it available on ncert.nic.in. NCERT has also converted its text books of Classes 9 to 12 on all subjects including Languages, Mathematics, Science and Social Sciences into eBooks. Funds for this purpose are being utilised within the grants available with the NCERT. E-books provide students and teachers free and unhindered access to the textbooks with the available electronic devices and software formats.
