- (b) the outcome of the census, national as well as State/UT level, thereof; and
- (c) the salient features of various schemes being implemented/proposed to be implemented by the Union Government on the basis of the BPL census carried out by the Government.

- (a)& (b) The last BPL Census was conducted in 2002 using the methodology of score based ranking of rural households for which 13 socio-economic parameters were used based on the recommendation of an Expert Group constituted by the Ministry of Rural Development. The Ministry of Rural Development. The State-wise available details of BPL Households identified by the States/UTs are at Annexure.
- (c) The Ministry of Rural Development has been implementing various poverty alleviation schemes in rural areas of the country through the State/UT Governments. Two programmes,namely, (i) Indira AwaasYojana(IAY)(ii) National Social Assistance Programmes(NSAP) are implemented on the basis of the BPL census.
