(a) & (b) The Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), currently, provides for setting up of secondary schools(class IX-X) within a reasonable distance of every habitation, improving quality of education imparted at secondary level through making all secondary schools conform to prescri- bed norms, removal of gender, socio-economic and disability barriers. There is no proposal to set up special senior secondary schools under RMSA.
