The University Grants Commi- ssion (UGC) and Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) have requested all Universities and all Heads of Schools affiliated to CBSE, respectively to cele- brate Matribhasha Diwas on 21st February, 2015 to promote the use of mother tongue by conducting day long activities like song recitation, competitions, elocutions, debates, creative writing, etc., high- lighting the importance of Mother Tongue, the need to acquire all four skills of languages, preservation and promotion of all Mother Tongues, atti- tude of appreciating and learning other languages and advantages of learning more languages.
