Identification of villages and finalization of parameters for their selection is under process.
- (c): All sixteen IITs viz. IIT-Delhi, IIT-Bombay, IIT-Kharagpur, IIT-Kanpur, IIT-Madras, IIT-Roorkee, IIT-Guwahati, IIT-BHU, IIT-Hyderabad, IIT-Indore, IIT-Jodhpur, IIT-Mandi, IIT-Patna, IIT-Ropar, IIT- Gandhinagar, IIT-Bhubaneswar are involved in the Scheme in addition to IISER-Bhopal and MNIT-Jaipur.
