- (b) if so, the details thereof, State and location- wise; and
- (c) the time by which these universities and colleges are likely to be made functional?

(a) & (b): No Central Law University has been set up by the Government. The Bar Council of India (BCI) has informed that it has accorded statutory approvals to 92 proposals for setting up of Law Universities and Colleges in various States and Union Territories of the country, during the period January, 2013 to December, 2014 as per location-wise details at Annexure.

(c): Such details are not centrally maintained.
