RECONSTITUTION OF CABE

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to reconstitute the Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE);
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the present composition of members of the CABE;
- (d) whether the Government has consulted State Governments and eminent educationalists before taking this decision; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof ?

Answer

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (c): Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) was reconstituted on 18th May, 2012 for tenure of three years. The Members of the CABE usually consist of Central Ministers and Education Ministers of State Governments, Government Officers, Academics and other renowned personalities from different walks of life. Present composition of the CABE constituted vide Resolution dated 18th May, 2012 and subsequently modified vide Resolutions dated 15th Feb., 2013, 31st May, 2013 and 21st Nov., 2013 is at Annexure. The tenure of the present Board is upto 17th May, 2015. Since, a number of changes have occurred in the present composition of CABE, both of ex-officio members as also of nominated members, Ministry of HRD proposes to reconstitute it.
