As per the revised Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) "Vocationalisation of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education" efforts will be made by the States/UTs to mainstream children belonging to special focus groups i.e. SC, ST, OBC, minorities, persons below poverty line and children with special needs, with special attention to the girls belonging to these groups. Special priority would be given for introduction of vocational education in schools in identified SC, ST and minority concentrated districts/blocks. States/UTs will encourage and ensure the participation of students belonging to the special focus groups in vocational education through suitable measures including enrolment drives, provision of special facilities, working in close collaboration with parents and community based organization, monitoring attendance, organizing remedial classes and follow up of special groups etc.
