Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the rural families belonging to Scheduled Castes (SCs)/Scheduled Tribes (STs) and non-SCs/STs living below poverty line are provided any financial assistance for construction of houses;

(b) if so, the total number of housing units constructed during the last three years and the current year, State/year-wise;

(c) whether the Government proposes to provide free houses to the persons for SCs/STs in the country including Uttar Pradesh;

(d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

(a) Yes, Sir. Under Indira AwaasYojana (IAY) financial assistance of Rs.70,000/- in plain areas and Rs.75,000/- in hilly/difficult areas and IAP districts is provided to arural BPL household for construction of house. At the national level, 60% of IAY funds are earmarked for SCs and STs, 15% for beneficiaries from among the minorities and 3% for beneficiaries from among persons with disabilities.

(b) A statement showing the total number of housing units constructed during the last three years and the current year, State-wise is at Annexure.

(c) to (e) At present, there is no such proposal apart from the existing IAY Scheme.
