(c): Government has deregulated the petrol and diesel prices, and has also launched a new universal Direct Benefit Transfer Scheme for LPG from 1st January, 2015 onwards which covers both Aadhaar card and non-Aadhaar card holders in which the subsidy will be transferred directly into the bank accounts of cash-transfer- compliant customers in a manner that will avoid duplication and prevent leakages. The Government has also launched a dedicated scheme for end-to-end computerization of Public Distribution System throughout the country. 11 states have already joined the National Food Security Act (NFSA) framework, and as the required systems are in place, the other states will follow suit. The Government has simultaneously launched a drive to ensure universal coverage of Aadhaar throughout the country. End-to-end computerization, combined with universal Aadhaar coverage will help improve the targeting efficiency of PDS system in the country.
