(a) to (d): National Film Heritage Mission (NFHM) is a new Plan Scheme to restore, digitize and archive films and filmic material through National Film Archive of India. Administrative approval for implementation of the scheme has been issued on 24.11.2014 to undertake preservation and restoration of India's film heritage in a mission mode spread over a period of 7 years with a total outlay of Rs.597.41 Crore.
