- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct small reserviors and dams for utilization of water available in the country for drinking water and irrigation projects;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; state-wise and
- (c) the amount earmarked/allocated for this purpose, State-wise?

(a) to (c) Water Resource Project are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priorities. In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, Government of India provides technical and financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes and programmes such as Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP); and scheme for Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of water bodies etc.
