Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the total funds allocated by the Union Government to Telangana under the National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) after the State came into being;

(b) the number of youth who have been provided skill training and number of youth who have been benefited by such training and gainfully employed in Telangana;

(c) whether the Government proposes to allocate more funds under the NRLM to Telangana; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) After bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, the total funds allocated by the Union Government to Telangana under National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) is as under:

(a) Under National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM), unemployed youth in rural areas are trained under the Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) scheme and Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY). Whereas the trainings under RSETIs are focussed on self employment, the DDU-GKY focuses on skilling for wage employment in a Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode with assured placements in regular jobs in an organization. Total number of youth trained and placed under RSETIs and DDU-GKY during 2014-15 is as under:
