NEW TOURISM POLICY TO PROMOTE TOURISM

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has formulated a new tourism policy to promote tourism in the country;
- (b) if so, the details and the salient features of the policy;
- (c) the funds allocated by the Government in this regard during the last three years;
- (d) whether the Government has taken any steps to develop the Shivhar Dham in Madhya Pradesh; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a) to (c): The Ministry of Tourism has formu- lated a National Tourism Policy in the year 2002 with a view to positioning tourism as a major engine of economic growth, enhancing employment potential within the tourism sector as well as to foster economic integration through developing linkages with other sectors. The Ministry has now initi- ated the process of formulation of a New Tourism Policy 2015, keeping in mind changes in the global tourism scenario and inputs/ suggestions of stakeholders have been sought.
- (d) & (e): Identification, development and promotion of tourism is primarily undertaken by the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. However, Ministry of Tou- rism, Government of India provides Central Financial Assistance for tourism infrastru- cture projects which are prioritized in con- sultation with the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. Project proposals which are complete as per scheme guidelines are sanctioned and funds released subject to submission of utilization certificates for funds released earlier, inter-se priority and availability of funds. The Ministry of Tourism has not received any proposal for development of Shivhar Dham from Government of Madhya Pradesh.
