(a) to (f): Government of India has introduced Tourist Visa on Arrival enabled with Electronic Travel Authori- sation to facilitate foreign travelers visiting India. This facility is already available to the nationals of 44 countries and at 9 airports (viz. Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Kolkata, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Thiruvanantha- puram, Kochi and Goa airports) where all necessary infrastructure has already been provided.
