Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal with the Gove- rnment for making mandatory to all new structure to implement solar panel to reduce and save energy and electricity;

(b) if so, whether the Government has initiated any guidelines and instructed State Governments in this regard; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR POWER, COAL & NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a): No, Madam. However, Ministry of New and Renewable Energy is implementing a 'Grid Connected Rooftop and Small Solar Power Plants Programme' that encourages the installation of solar rooftop systems to reduce and save energy and electricity across the country.

(b)&(c): The Ministry has been continuously requesting State Governments to promote grid connected rooftop solar systems in their States. So far, State Elect- ricity Regulatory Commissions from 17 States/UTs namely Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand and West Bengal, Andaman & Nicobar, Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep, Pondicherry and Goa have notified the regulations that include promotion of grid connected rooftop solar systems with net metering/feed-in-tariff mechanism.
