- (a) whether the Government is working on a scheme to set up 20,000 MW solar power projects through qualified unemployed or under employed youth, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether any criteria has been fixed for these unemployed youth to apply for the project, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government also proposes to extend assistance to keep power tariff from solar plants set up under this scheme affordable for State uti- lities, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to involve State Governments in this regard, if so, the response of the State Governments in this regard; and
- (e) the other steps taken/being taken by the Gover- nment to ramp up solar power capacity to 100000 MW by 2021-2022?

Answer

- (a): Yes, Madam. A new scheme is under preparation.
- (b): The eligibility criteria for selection is under preparation.
- (c): Under the scheme, the State Electricity Commission is proposed to fix the tariff based upon the petition filed by the distribution companies.
- (d): Yes, Madam. However, the scheme is under finalisation.
- (e): The scale up plan to ramp up solar power capacity to 100000 MW by 2021-22 is under advance stage of preparation.
