- (a) whether there is an acute shortage of Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officers in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the number of sanctioned posts of IAS officers at present, State/UT-wise;
- (d) the number of officers employed at present on the sanctioned posts, State/ UT-wise; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to meet the shortage of IAS officers?

## **Answer**

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

- (a) to (d): The Total Administrative Strength (TAS) of officers in position and vacancy position in Indian Administrative Service (IAS), state-wise is at Annexure-I.
- (e): In order to address the issue of shortage of IAS in Regular Recruitment quota, the Government has increased annual intake of officers from 55 in Civil Services Examination (CSE) 1998 to 180 in CSE 2013 in respect of IAS. In promotion quota, prompt actions have been taken for holding Selection Committee Meetings for appointment by promotion/selecting State Service officers to IAS.
