- (a)&(b):No Madam. However, some Major-Ports have insured some equipments such as cranes, marine crafts, vehicles, equipments, computers, plants and machinery etc.
- (c): Rule 15 of Delegation of Financial Power Rules, 1978 provides that Government property, both immovable or immovable, shall not be insured and no subordinate authority shall undertake or incur any expenditure in connection with these insurance of such property without the previous consent of Ministry of Finance. However, equipments that are costly and sensitive may be insured if considered necessary.
