(a)&(b): Ganga- Bhagirathi- Hooghly River System from Allahabad to Haldia has been declared as National Waterway. Conservancy works, which also include dredging, are being carried out in this stretch of River Ganga to maintain the targeted depth for movement of passenger and cargo. The dredging is a seasonal activity undertaken every year and helps in maintaining desired depth for promoting passengers and cargo traffic which will help the economy.

(c)&(d):Yes, Madam. A proposal which covers 101 waterways across the country, has been prepared for the declaration of more waterways as National Waterways by the Government. The proposal covers 101 waterways across the country.
