(a)&(b):A committee comprising of Chief Engineer, Chief Mechanical Engineer, Financial Adviser, Chief Accounts Officer, Traffic Manager and Deputy Conservator of Mumbai Port Trust has been constituted to review the issues relating to handling of coal, Ship breaking and General Cargo.

(c)&(d): No. There is no proposal to shift oil traffic out of Mumbai Port.
