(a) & (b) There are over 70 skill development schemes across various sectors being implemented by over 20 Central Ministries/Departments. Most of these schemes have special provisions to promote the participation in skill development programmes by all socio-economic groups, including women. 30% of all the seats for the courses in all Government and Private ITIs are reserved for women candidates including widows.
