(a) to (c): Ministry of Home Affairs has informed that Self-defence skills are being encouraged and imparted in many States / UTs to women and children more as a confidence building measure rather than a substitute to State policy. Further as per Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India "Police" and "Public Order" are State subjects and, as such, the primary responsibility of prevention, detection, registration, investigation and prosecution of crime, lies with the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. Government of India is deeply concerned with the welfare of women and through various legislations, schemes and advisories impacting women's safety to the State Governments / Union Territory Administrations, augment the efforts of the States /UTs.
