(a) to (d): The Centrally Sponsored Schemes(CSS)/programmes being implemented in the Ministry alongwith the funds allocated and released in the last two years and current year are at Annexure.

The Government has adopted an integrated approach in the implementation of the various Centrally Sponsored Schemes in the education sector. In order to optimize the utility of the CSS, 16 CSS of the Department of School Education & Literacy have been restructured into 6 schemes while 2 schemes of the Department of Higher Education have been restructured into 1 CSS during the XII five year plan period.
