- (b): The number of students belonging to SC/ST categories, who have benefited from the scheme of Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship for SC/ST candidates, during 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14, State/UT wise is at Annexure-II.
- (c) & (d): The UGC has stated that there is no mismatch between the funds released and utilized under the scheme.
- (e):Funds under the scheme are being released through e-payment under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) scheme.
