- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase the allocation of NCEF funds to MNRE for the implementation of its programmes and schemes, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of the NCEF resources used for financing clean energy projects in India so far?

- (a)&(b): Yes Madam, the Government of India has started Levying increased clean energy cess on coal since 11 July 2014.
- (c): For the year 2015-16, the budget estimates for the National Clean Energy Fund (NCEF) is Rs. 13180.04 crore.
- (d): No, Madam.
- (e): The Inter Ministerial Group (IMG), constituted by the Ministry of Finance to recommend the funding under NCEF has so far approved 46 projects for a NCEF support of Rs16511.43 crore, as detailed at Annexure.
