Will the Minister of PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to reserve certain posts of Government jobs as religious quota for the Muslims, Christians and other minorities; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) & (b): The Government vide Department of Personnel and Training's O.M. No. 41018/2/2011- Estt.(Res.) dated 22/12/2011 had carved out a sub-quota of 4.5% for Minorities from within the 27% reservation available for Other Backward Classes (OBCs). The sub-quota was applicable only to those Minorities who were included in the Central List of OBCs.

Subsequently, the High Court of judicature at Hyderabad quashed these instructions. A Special Leave Petition (SLP) has been filed by Ministry of Human Resource Development in the Hon'ble Supreme Court against the order passed by the High Court. The matter is sub-judice.
