Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the annual revenue earned by the Government from the sale of costly gift items in the flights of Indigo Airlines during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether the airlines are given licenses for the sale of gift items at very high prices during the flight; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the action taken or proposed to be taken by the Government against Indigo Airlines?

Answer

(a) to (c) Selling of gift items are the commercial aspect of air transport services and DGCA does not interfere in the matter. Therefore, information on revenue earned by the scheduled domestic airlines from the sale of costly gift itmes in the flights is not required to be submitted to DGCA and accordingly DGCA does not maintain such record.
