The Aviation Cooperation Programme is a public-private partnership between the United States Trade and Development Agency (USTDA), the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and US aviation companies. No proposal with regard to increase co-operation in aviation sector is under consideration with Ministry of Civil Aviation at present.
