## Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether an Air India's flight has recently suffered tyre burst while landing in Kochi and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether this incident has been investigated and if so, the details and the findings thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken or being taken by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation to avert such incidents in future?

## **Answer**

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Dr Mahesh Sharma)

- (a) and (b): Yes, Madam. Air India flight A320 aircraft VT-ESB was involved in an incident of tyre burst and hydraulic fluid leakage from left hand main landing gear during landing at Cochin while operating flight Al-167 (Delhi-Cochin) of 26.02.2015. The incident has been investigated. Investigation has revealed that the No.2 Main wheel tyre of the left hand side got de-capped which led to tyre burst and leakage in brake hydraulic pipe line.
- (c): All tyre burst incidents involving consequential damage to the aircraft are investigated. Recommendations emanating from the investigation reports are implemented to avert such incidents.
