- (a) & (b) The Central Government has initiated a feasibility study on the possibility of setting up a National Level Institute of Sanitation and Hygiene in the Country.
- (c) and (d) Since the proposal is at the preliminary stage of feasibility study, the States have not been consulted so far for the setting up of the Institute.
- (e) As the Feasibility Study for the proposed Centre has not yet been completed, it is not possible at this stage to give a time frame for the Center to start functioning.
