Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of various subsidies provided for construction of individual household toilets and toilets in public places in rural areas of the country including Bihar, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to increase subsidies given under various sanitation schemes; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER & SANITATION(SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a) The Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) launched on 2nd October, 2014, provides for incentives for the construction of Individual household latrine (IHHL) of Rs.12000, including Central share of Rs.9000.00 (Rs. 10800.00 in case of special category states) and State share of Rs. 3000.00 (Rs. 1200.00 in case of special category states) for all Below poverty Line (BPL) households and to identified Above Poverty Line (APL) households (all SCs /STs, small and marginal farmers, landless labourers with homestead, physically handicapped and women-headed households). Provision for construction of Community Sanitary Complexes in public place is Rs.200000, including Central share of Rs.120000, State share of Rs.60000 and Community/GP share of Rs. 20000.

(c) Incentive for Individual household latrines has been recently revised w.e.f. 2nd October, 2014.
