(a) to (d): Project Monitoring and Coordination Groups for each Railway Zone headed by Chief Administrative Officer/Construction of the Railway and, having representatives from State Government and Railways have been formed. The objective of these groups is to expedite the project implementation.

There is no proposal to form District/Division Level Monitoring Committees for execution / implementation of Railway projects in the country.

All Zonal Railways have been directed to hold meetings of Project Monitoring and Coordination Groups at regular intervals to expedite the project execution.
