MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a): Yes, Madam. Korba – Gevra Road is already on existing rail line and Gevra Road - Pendra Road New line project in Chhattisgarh (122 km) is being implemented by a Joint Venture with participation of South Eastern Coalfields Limited (64%), Ircon International Limited (26%) and Government of Chhattisgarh (10%).

(b): Detailed Project Report (DPR) of the work has been prepared.

(c): Target for implementation of project is 4 years after land acquisition and forest clearance.
