(a) to (c): Survey for construction of Kannur-Mattanur new line was completed in January, 2013. As per the survey report, cost of construction of 23 Km. long new line has been assessed as `237 crore with a negative rate of return of 4%. Due to huge throwforward of ongoing new line projects and limited overall availability of funds, the proposed project could not be taken forward.
