THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (GEN. RETD. V.K. SINGH)

(a) & (b) Government's consistent and principled position is that the entire State of Jammu and Kashmir is an integral part of the Indian Union. A part of the territory of the State is under the forcible and illegal occupation of Pakistan. Under the Simla Agreement, India and Pakistan are committed to address all outstanding issues including the issue of Jammu and Kashmir, peacefully through bilateral dialogue. There is, therefore, no scope for a third party role or mediation in this process.
