(b) and (c): 'Policing' on Railways being a State subject, FIRs on crime against passengers are lodged with, registered and investigated by the Government Railway Police of the concerned State.

Ministry of Railway have ensured that TTEs and Escort Parties of Government Railway Police and Railway Protection Force on board carry FIR forms to enable passenger to file complaints without breaking their journey.
