Bottom of Form A multi stakeholder New Education Policy Task Force (NEPTF), at the national level has been set up, which comprises of the senior officials and the thematic nodal officers of Ministry of Human Resource Development, representatives of various Ministries/Departments of the Government of India, Heads of University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA), National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) and Chief Executive Officer, MyGov, Department of Electronics and Information Technology (DeitY). The Task Force is expected to periodically monitor the progress of the consultation process and submit the report through Secretary (School Education & Literacy) and Secretary (Higher Education) to the Minister for Human Resource Development.
