- (a) the total candidates appeared in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) and qualified during the last three years;
- (b) whether there has been a decline in the pass percentage of candidates appeared in CTET over the years;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the financial assistance given for implementation and functioning of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Teacher Education?

Answer

- (a): 47,51,354 candidates appeared and 2,72,253 candidates qualified in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) during the last three years .
- (b): The pass percentage in CTET examination in July, 2013 was 9.29% whereas in February, 2015 the pass percentage was 12.18% .
- (c): Does not arise.
- (d): Financial assistance is given under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Teacher Education for Salary Component, Programmes & Activities and Infrastructural Development related to Teacher Education Institutions.
