(a) whether the Maharashtra Government has urged the Union Government to sanction 5505 posts of part time instructors for 1835 Government upper primary schools along with financial approval of Rs. 13.75 crore;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the present status of the proposal; and

(c) the time by which the same is likely to be approved?

(a) to (c): The Maharashtra Government first proposed 5505 part time instructors for 1835 Government upper primary schools with financial approval for ? 13.76 crore and subsequently revised their request to 9861 posts of part time instructors for 3287 schools, for approval under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Programme.

In the Project Approval Board (PAB) meeting to discuss the Annual Work Plan & Budget for Maharashtra for 2015-16, the PAB has agreed to the State's request for 9861 posts.
