MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (c): The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has been established with the view to promote technical education in the country. The Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of proper planning and co-ordinated development, promotion of qualitative improvement, planned quantitative growth, regulations and proper maintenance of norms and standards in the technical education system and other matters related therewith. The AICTE also grants approval for starting new Technical Institutions, introduction of courses or programs and increase / variation of intake capacity of seats for the courses or programs and extension of approval for the existing technical Institutions, which inter-alia meant to promote as well as the maintenance of norms and standards in the technical education in the country. The Government has also established 87 Centrally Funded Technical Institutions which includes Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs), Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs), National Institutes of Technology (NITs), Indian Institutes of Science Education & Research (IISERs) etc providing quality education in the field of technical education.
