(a) to (d): Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation Ltd.

(IRCTC) has launched co-branded Prepaid Card with Union Bank of India on Rupay Platform on 24th March, 2015. The card has been developed jointly by IRCTC, UBI and National Payment Corporation of India (NPCI). The salient features of the card are as under:

- 1. It is not a debit card.
- 2. At present, the card can be used for online ticketing.
- 3. There are two types of cards and the fees charged to the customer are:
- a) Physical card: `50/- per card.
- b) Virtual card: NIL
- c) During first six months of the launch of the card, `10/- plus taxes per transaction after first five transactions per card per month is charged.
- d) After six months of the launch of the card `10/- plus taxes per transaction is charged.
