Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways have planned to produce coaches for high speed locomotives to develop high speed train facilities in the country;
- (b) if so, whether the Railways also propose to upgrade the railways lines in this regard; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the details about the fast train tracks identified by the Railways?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) Rail Coach Factory, Kapurthala has been advised to develop prototype coaches with a speed potential of 200 kmph, with technical assistance from Research Design & Standards Organisation (RDSO) of Indian Railways.
- (b) & (c) Indian Railways has identified nine corridors for raising the speed of passenger trains to 160 kmph in phase-I and thereafter to 200 kmph in phase-II. The corridors are: Delhi-Agra, Delhi-Chandigarh, Delhi-Kanpur, Nagpur-Bilaspur, Mysore-Bengaluru-Chennai, Mumbai-Goa, Mumbai-Ahmedabad, Chennai-Hyderabad and Nagpur-Secunderabad. For raising the speed of passenger trains to 160/200 kmph, technical inputs to track such as provision of 60 kg rail, provision of thick web switches and provision of improved switch expansion joints etc. are required.
