(a) This information is maintained Zone-wise. Details of loading points covered with Terminal Management System(TMS) over different Zonal Railways are given below:

(b) to (d) All loading points on Indian Railways are covered with weighbridges, which have been either installed at the loading point itself or provided linkage with notified associate/alternate associate weighbridge, for weighing of wagons.
