(a) & (b): Project proposals for construction of Study Circle/Centre have been received from some States under Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP). But they could not be agreed to for lack of proper justification for taking them up under MsDP. However, as a follow-up action on one of the recommendations of Sachar Committee, all the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations have been advised by the Ministry of Human Resource Development for using existing school buildings and community buildings in the evenings as the study centres for school children.
