- (a) No, Madam. At present there is no such proposal.
- (b) As announced in the Railway Budget 2013-14, Fare and Freight revision linked to fuel cost can be done twice a year, in sync with movement in fuel cost, in either direction.
- (c) & (d) The impact of the last Fuel Adjustment Component (FAC)-linked tariff revision, effected from 25.06.2014, on the essential commodities has been assessed as under:
